

SCRAPPY ZIPPERED TOTE BAG

This is an amazing versatile and easy to make tote bag. You can make it any size you want by varying the size of the squares, and add whatever you desire for inside pockets: zipper pockets, elastic pockets, whatever. This bag has one outside pocket and three inside pockets. You can make it as a scrappy bag or use your favorite fabric to make it a fall color, spring, red, blue, or whatever color bag. How about making one for every color outfit?



We will cover making the bag in one class. There are no patterns to buy as this is not a copyrighted bag. Fabric requirements are minimal. We can always use a pattern to use up our scraps, right?

CLASS REQUIREMENTS

Seventy Six (76) 3 ½ squares of chosen fabric or smaller size to make a smaller bag

1 ½ yd of Peltex

1 yd of inside fabric. Ladies tell me you should use something other than black so you can find things inside the bag

Four (4) WOF strips of bias strip. A quarter yard of fabric will do. I will bring a bias strip maker to class; you just need four 2" strips to make the bias strips.

For the handle use two strips 3 ½ x 28"

Topstitch or denim needles and a spare

One 18" zipper for top of bag if desired

Sewing machine, rotary cutter, pins, scissors, and all the usual sewing stuff.
